An exhibition of new work by Anthony Keogh from 7th - 20th May

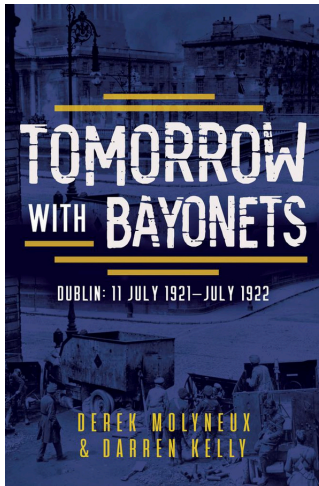
### Seychelles & India: A Postal Exhibition
