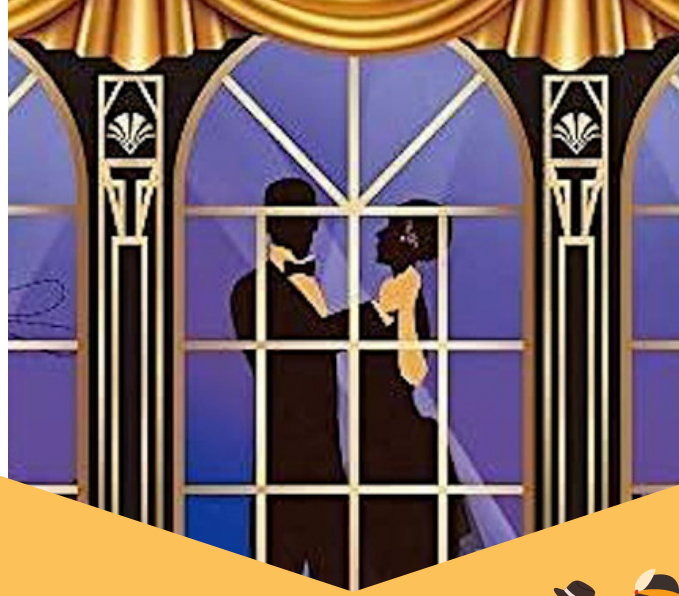
SCRABBLE CLUB
