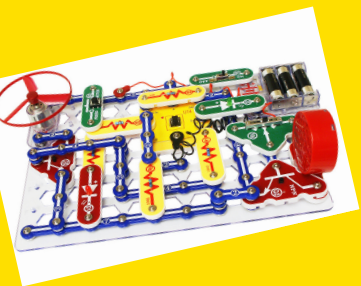


Family Snap Circuits
