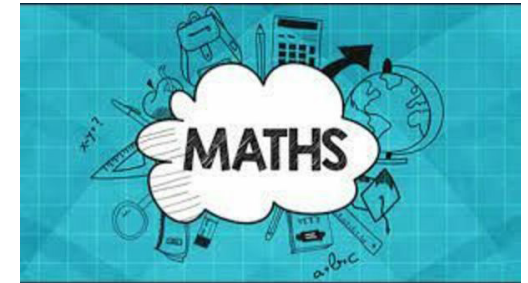

Sonas are the largest provider of the front-line services for victims of domestic abuse in the country. They provide Refuge, Safe Homes, Transitional Housing, Outreach, Crisis Intervention, Helpline, and Court Accompaniment services to victims of Domestic Abuse. They support approximately 1,250 women and children in our services each year.

Sonas are hosting an exhibition for international Women's day against Gender-Based Violence in the Month of March that will feature 16 portraits of victims of Femicide and Filicide. The aim of this event is to raise awareness of the impact of Domestic Abuse and Feminicide in Ireland, to promote the collaborative effort for accountability, and to inspire guests that a world without Domestic Violence is possible.



This exhibition will be on display in Tallaght Library from the 8th March to the 24th March.

At the launch of the exhibition there will also be an information stand on Domestic Violence between 12:00 and 15:00.
