

CRITERIA

Annette Halpin Memorial Music Award 2014

This award is available for young musicians/composers/singers (up to 25 years of age), living, working or studying in South Dublin County Council Administrative area. The aim of the award is to support musical development or professional development within music. This might include but is not exclusive to master classes, purchase of instruments, recording, or travel. Proposals should demonstrate development in the context of the applicant's work.

The maximum amount of this award is €2000. Judges will have the discretion to split the award between a number of applicants.

Assessment Criteria

- The significance of the proposal to the musical development of the applicant
- The viability of the proposal and the ability of the applicant to realise their aspirations within the time and resources available
- The ability to demonstrate financial assistance.

Terms & Conditions

- Funding provided by South Dublin County Council must be acknowledged in all publicity material associated with the work. South Dublin County Council logos are available from the South Dublin County Council Arts Office. Copies of promotional material and completed work must be given to the Arts Office.
- The funding cannot be passed on to a third party. You may not apply on behalf of someone else.
- Successful applicants will be asked to participate in evaluation of the fund by providing a short written report describing their experiences and the contribution of the fund to their development.
- Successful applicants may be asked to contribute to South Dublin County Council Arts Office promotional material.
