

- 7. Participate in an ongoing network of schools to support your efforts
- **8**. Complete a questionnaire to evaluate your progress

Pilot Programme Results

The initial pilot project with 98 schools in the Dublin area in 2021-2 resulted in:

- Individual schools reducing their waste by 10-50%
- Schools saved hundreds to thousands of Euros in unnecessary waste collection charges
- Great feedback from schools who were delighted with the online training, site visits, technical support and composting bins & tools provided



The programme was recognised as Ireland's best waste reduction education initiative by Repak in November of 2022.

We are now working with about 100 more schools this year in the Dublin area, Wicklow, Meath, Laois and Cork.
