•	The Group outlined their concerns regarding road safety for pedestrians crossing the road as there is no pedestrian crossing in place. As there is no safe place to cross the road some parents are driving the short distance to school instead of walking with the children.	
•	Requested a footfall count to be carried out before the schools break up for summer holidays.	
•	The Group also stated that more traffic will be expected along this route when the extension of the LUAS line is operational.	
•	The Part 8 will be examined to see if a pedestrian crossing was included.	Mbakure Johnson
