

It is proposed to receive the under mentioned Deputation in the Council Chamber, County Hall, Tallaght, Dublin 24 on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2011.

The matters for discussion are set out below:

## 3.00pm – 3.45pm Kew Park Estate Residents Association

#### 1. Entrance to Kew Park -

After the road works at the entrance to Kew Park was completed, the grass verge on either side of the entrance has not been put back to the way it was. It is in very bad condition. What can be done to bring it back to how it was before the work was carried out? SDCC were out to see it and agreed that it needed to be fixed. The work is still outstanding.

Grass cuttings – there is a lot of correspondence in connection with who is responsible. Basically the entrance does not look as good at it did before the road works. All the residents are looking for, is what we had originally – grass cut and flower display at entrance.

### 2. Trees in the area need to be cut –

The Residents Association was told this would be done in October, it still hasn't been completed. **Hedging in the Daisy Patch** – work was to be carried out, but hasn't been done so far.

# 3. Kerbing from the footpaths to the road –

This was on our Deputation Meeting Agenda over the last couple of years. The kerbing was broken when the estate was tarmacadamed in 2008. Michael Glynn was to report back to the Residents Association on the outcome of an inspection that was to be carried out. We have had no correspondence and the kerbs are deteriorating and in urgent need of repair. This is a safety risk to our residents.

**4. Graffiti -** in the back field (Daisy Patch), has increased. Can it be painted and plants planted by SDCC.

#### 5. Steps for Plebiscite –

A survey was carried out by the Council and a design proposal was to be drafted. David Fennell was supposed to contact the Residents Association regarding the design proposal but we have not heard anything. Could we have an update?
