Items discussed:

1. Tree Planting.

The group acknowledge and accept the work that has taken place on trees in the area. The group are grateful that the tree stumps have been removed and the engagement on the subject with SDCC. The group in consultation with Public Realm have planted around 10 trees in the grass verges. The group now want to move on and get some additional greenery into the areas that has been left barren.
