- 1. Regular maintenance and cleaning front of Springfield Estate, Old Blessington Road including litter collection.
- 2. Replacement of trees which have been cut down over the past few months in the estate and removal of tree stumps left behind, also request for more trees and bushes to be planted on all greens on open spaces in Springfield.
- 3. The Cookstown Road need to be revamped i.e. paths filled in and grass on top of (Maplewood Road between Supervalu and Junior School).
- 4. Replace Street Lights on Open Greens in Springfield with are very dark areas which need brighter ones to give out more light in the interest of Resident Safety.
- 5. Resurfacing of the paths on Maplewood Green as this area is prone to flooding every year in the winter, resulting in children and elderly people not being able to use it to access shops and schools.
