ESB Tree Week 2016 runs from Sunday March 6th until Sunday March 13th.



PURE Music

Pure Music Environmental Training Programme is a **FREE** two day environmental/music training programme for teenagers (13 to 18 years old) who are involved in a music class, play a musical instrument, in a band, or



sing. This two day training programme is for a maximum of 10/12 students, ideally suited to a secondary school music class.

PURE will introduce students to important environmental issues that are related to the Project, e.g., illegal dumping, litter, fly-tipping, recycling, pollution, environment and community. This will then lead into the second day of the training programme, and in collaboration with professional musicians, participants learn about song writing, music composition and music production, culminating in the creation and recording of an original song and music video!
