Governance and Standing Orders

A subgroup to begin work on the 3 year Community Safety Plan was established.

Public Meeting – 14th May 2026

Following a discussion regarding the requirement to hold a public meeting. Members agreed to hold a public meeting on the 14th May 2026 at 7.30 p.m. in Tallaght Stadium. The public meeting will be an introduction to the new Local Community Safety Partnership Structure.

The purpose of this event will be to:

- Provide an overview of the LCSP and its role
- Introduce the member organisations and agencies involved
- Offer the public an opportunity to engage directly with partners
- Facilitate round table discussions to help inform and shape the LCSP work plan
- Agencies to have information stands for the public to interact with

Holding the public meeting early on was recognised as a valuable opportunity for community engagement, enabling members of the public to understand the new partnership model and contribute to its priorities.
