Tá muinín againn go dtiocfaidh smaointe úra as an bpróiseas comhoibríoch seo lena gcuirfear tuilleadh feabhais ar infheistíocht sna Tionscail Ealaíon, Oidhreacht agus Cruthaitheacht agus lena gcuirfear bonn eolais fúthu sna blianta amach romhainn.

CLÁR ÉIRE ILDÁNACH

The Creative Ireland Programme is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 – a five-year initiative, from 2017 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy. It is a high-level, high-ambition, all-of-government initiative to mainstream creativity in the life of the nation so that individually and collectively, in our personal lives and in our institutions, we can realise our full creative potential.

The Creative Ireland Programme is a culture-based programme designed to promote individual, community and national wellbeing. The core proposition is that participation in cultural activity drives personal and collective creativity, with significant implications for individual and societal wellbeing and achievement.

The Creative Ireland Programme is also the main implementation vehicle for the priorities identified in the Government's policy document, Culture 2025 -Éire Ildánach which states that arts and culture are intrinsic to the Irish State, acknowledges the need to increase access to, and participation in the arts, boost our creative industries, and preserve our heritage with a particular focus on language, landscape and the environment..

The programme is built around the themes of identity, culture and citizenship. The core operating principles are Collaboration and Communication, Community Empowerment, and Internationalisation.

Clár Oidhreacht de chuid an Rialtais is ea Clár Éire Chruthaitheach d'Éirinn 2016 – tionscnamh cúig bliana, ó 2017 go 2022, ina gcuirtear an chruthaitheacht ag lár an bheartais phoiblí. Tionscnamh ardleibhéil, ard-uailmhianach, an rialtais uile is ea é chun cruthaitheacht a phríomhshruthú i saol ár náisiúin ionas go mbeimid ábalta, inár n-aonar agus le chéile, inár saolta pearsanta agus inár n-institiúidí, ár n-acmhainneacht chruthaitheach iomlán a bhaint amach.

Clár bunaithe ar Chultúr is ea Clár Éire Chruthaitheach atá deartha chun folláine daoine aonair, folláine an phobail agus an fholláine náisiúnta a chur chun cinn. Is é an príomh-mholadh go spreagann rannpháirtíocht i ngníomhaíocht chultúrtha cruthaitheacht phearsanta agus chomhchoiteann d'fholláine agus d'éacht daoine aonair agus na sochaí.

Is é Clár Éire Chruthaitheach an phríomhfheithicil cur chun feidhme chomh maith maidir leis na tosaíochtaí arna n-aithint i ndoiciméad beartais an Rialtais, Cultúr 2025 -Éire Ildánach ina sonraítear go bhfuil na healaíona agus an cultúr bunúsach do stát na hÉireann, ina n-adhmaítear an gá le méadú a dhéanamh ar rochtain ar na healaíona agus a bheith páirteach iontu, borradh a chur faoinár dtionscail chruthaitheacha, agus ár n-oidhreacht a chaomhnú agus fócas faoi leith a chur ar an teanga, tírdhreach agus comhshaol.

Tá an clár forbartha thart ar na téamaí um fhéiniúlacht, cultúr agus saoránacht. Is iad na príomhphrionsabail oibriúcháin Comhoibriú agus Cumarsáid, Cumhachtú an Phobail, agus Idirnáisiúnú.

Local authorities have a crucial role in the overall local delivery of the entire Creative Ireland programme and are exclusively mandated, through their culture teams, to deliver Pillar 2 of the programme – Enabling Creativity in Every Community. This devolution of responsibility for Creative Ireland to local authorities is inspired by the extraordinary impact of collaborative local authority co-ordinated projects for the centenary of 1916. This Plan sets out the beginning of South Dublin's part in this five-year journey, a truly important national policy initiative centred on culture and wellbeing.'

The ambition for this Plan is to support and strengthen the cultural sector, artistic practices and creative industries in the County making the sector more sustainable. Here in South Dublin County, we are unfolding our cultural heritage through the development of the Round Tower Interpretative Centre in Clondalkin, the Hellfire project in the Dublin Mountains, and the associated programmes that will be generated from this. The County's heritage, and the investments in our cultural and tourism infrastructure, are key steps towards realising South Dublin County Council's ambition to become a significant destination for

Tá ról ríthábhachtach ag na húdaráis áitiúla maidir le seachadadh áitiúil foriomlán chlár Éire Chruthaitheach ina iomláine agus tá sainordú eisiach acu, trína bhfoirne cultúir, Colún 2 den chlár a sheachadadh – An Chruthaitheacht a Chumasú i nGach Pobal. Tá dílárú na freagrachta as Éire Chruthaitheach chuig na húdaráis áitiúla spreagtha ag tionchar neamhghnách chomhthionscadail chomhordaithe na n-údarás áitiúil do chomóradh céad bliain 1916. Sa phlean seo leagtar amach tús pháirt Chontae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas san aistear cúig bliana seo, tionscnamh náisiúnta beartas fíorthábhachtach atá dírithe ar an gcultúr agus ar an bhfolláine.”

Is é an uaillmhian leis an bPlean seo tacú leis an earnáil chultúrtha, cleachtais ealaíonta agus tionscail chruthaitheacha sa Chontae agus iad a neartú chun an earnáil a dhéanamh níos inbhuanaithe. Anseo i mBaile Átha Cliath Theas, tugaimid ár n-oidhreacht chultúrtha chun solais trí fhorbairt Ionad Léirmhínteach an Chloighí i gCluain Dolcáin, an tionscadal ‘Hellfire’ i Sléibhte Bhaile Átha Cliath, agus na cláir ghaolmhara a chruthófar mar thoradh air sin. Tá oidhreacht an Chontae, agus na hinfheistíochtaí inár mbonneagar cultúrtha agus turasóireachta, ina bpríomhchéimheanna i dtreo uaillmhian Chomhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas a bhaint amach maidir le bheith ina cheann scríbe suntasach do theaghlaigh a bhfuil cónaí orthu sa chontae seo agus do chuarteoirí.

A second key ambition for this Plan is the development of Tallaght as a creative hub in the county, building on the existing creative cluster of the Civic Theatre, Rua Red and the County Library, and the artists and organisations who interact with the public in these spaces. Cruinniú na Cásca 2017 provides an opportunity for collaboration between programmers and for wider public engagement.

Investment in creatives is a crucial part of the Plan which has been given consideration in discussions by the Culture Team and the Creative Ireland Workshop held in Tallaght in March 2017. Investment through a number of new awards and initiatives in 2017 is aimed at enhancing skills and fostering ambition.

The 2017 Plan will also make a space in the programme for networking, peer exchange, and public participation in cultural discussion and expression. This interaction will be a leading aspect of South Dublin County's Creative Ireland Programme into the future.

South Dublin County's Cultural Team anticipates that the impact of this Programme on people will be considerable, particularly when placed in conjunction with plans under the other four pillars of the Creative Ireland Programme.

Príomh-uaillmhian eile don Phlean seo is ea forbairt Thamhlachta mar mhol cruthaitheach sa chontae, ag baint leas as braisle chruthaitheach reatha na hAmharclainne Pobail, Rua Red agus an Leabharlann Chontae, agus na healaíontóirí agus na heagraíochtaí a idirghníomhaíonn leis an bpobal sna spásanna sin. Soláthraíonn Cruinniú na Cásca 2017 deis le haghaidh comhoibriú idir cláraitheoirí agus le haghaidh rannpháirtíocht phoiblí níos leithne.

Tá infheistíocht i lucht na n-ealaíon ina cuid rithábachtach den Phlean ar breathnaíodh air i bplé a rinne an Fhoireann Chultúir agus Ceardlann Éire Chruthaitheach a tionóladh i dTamhlacht i mí an Mhárta 2017. Tá infheistíocht trí líon dámhachtainí úra agus tionscnamh úr in 2017 dírithe ar scileanna a fheabhsú agus uaillmhian a chothú.

Cuirfidh Plean 2017 spás sa chlár chomh maith do líonrú, malartú ag piaraí, agus rannpháirtíocht phoiblí i bplé agus léiriú cultúrtha. Beidh an idirghníomhaíocht sin ina príomhghné de Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach Chontae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas sa toadhchaí.

Tá sé tuartha ag Foireann Chultúir Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas go mbeidh tionchar suntasach ag an gClár seo ar dhaoine, go háirithe nuair a chuirtear i gcomhar le pleananna é faoin gceithre cholún eile de Chlár Éire Chruthaitheach.

The Creative Ireland Team in South Dublin (The Culture Team) will work collaboratively to ensure that an ambitious Culture and Creativity Plan is generated, based on the principles of best practice, reflection and enquiry, open exchange, cultural diversity, and sustainability. The Culture Team will be coordinated by Orla Scannell, one of 31 national coordinators who work as a national team to deliver the Creative Ireland Programme. The team will monitor the progress of the Culture and Creativity Plan and will report its progress to Council, the public and key stakeholders. The full members of the Culture Team are:

Projects for 2017

TIONSCADAIL LE HAGHAIDH 2017

CREATIVE IRELAND PROGRAMME FUNDED PROJECTS FOR 2017

The following initiatives will be delivered in South Dublin County in 2017 using the Creative Ireland funds allocated to South Dublin County Council. These initiatives have been agreed by the Culture Team for 2017.

Crinniú na Cásca (Easter Monday)

South Dublin County in 2017 focused on Tallaght as a Creative Hub with a full programme of events hosted throughout the day. The programme marked a first collaboration in curating a programme by five of the County's Cultural organisations: Tallaght Community Arts, Rua Red South Dublin Arts Centre, the Civic Theatre, South Dublin Libraries and South Dublin Arts Office.

Artist & Creatives Collaborative Practice Award

This 2017 initiative seeks to support an artist or creative in any discipline in their collaborative practice. The successful proposal will have both a professional development element and a community element to it. It will engage with one or all three of the cultural venues in Tallaght and will have access to mentoring opportunities by these venues. The amount of the award is €15,000.

TIONSCADAIL CHISTITHE FAOI CHLÁR ÉIRE ILDÁNACH DON BHLIAIN 2017

Déanfar na tionscnaimh seo a leanas a sheachadadh i mBaile Átha Cliath Theas in 2017 ag baint leas as cistí Éire Chruthaitheach atá leithdháilte ar Chomhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas. Comhaontaíodh na tionscnaimh sin leis an bhFoireann Chultúir do 2017.

Cruinniú na Cásca (Luan Cásca)

Emerging Arts Group Incubation Award

The Culture team wishes to support collectives/groups of emerging young artists and creatives in any discipline, to develop their practice and to promote their presence as a creative and recognisable voice in the County. The amount of the award is €5000.

Schools Cultural Awards

Both primary schools and second level schools in the county will be invited to submit proposals for programmes and projects in the disciplines of Drama, Dance and Visual Arts that will enrich arts practice in schools in the county. The maximum amount of an award will be €2000. Five awards will be made in 2017.

The Round Tower Interpretative Centre

This new interpretative centre in Clondalkin will be opened from July 2017. A programme of heritage, arts and literature events will be devised for the new centre. The project has been developed as part of South Dublin County Tourism Strategy with historical information provided by South Dublin County Libraries.

Palmerstown Digital Hub

2017 will see the opening of a Digital Hub offering a living and meeting space for the local community in Palmerstown. The Hub will feature innovative technology providing easy access to self-service and online library services. A programme of children's activities and events will be planned as part of the array of services available.

Digitisation Programme

Digitisation of the Corkagh papers which relate to the Finlay and Colley families of Corkagh Demesne in Clondalkin which have been made available to South Dublin Libraries. A community-collaboration project is the transcription of the church records held by the National Library of Ireland for the South Dublin area; Saggart, Rathfarnham, Clondalkin, Palmerstown and Lucan parishes are available.

Mol Digiteach Bhaile Phámar

Osclofar Mol Digiteach in 2017 ina dtairgfear spás cónaithe agus cruinnithe don phobal áitiúil i mBaile Phámar. Beidh teicneolaíocht nuálach sa mhol a chuirfidh rochtain éasca ar fhéinseirbhís agus seirbhís leabharlainne ar líne ar fáil. Pleanálfar clár gníomhaíochtaí agus imeachta do pháistí mar chuid de raon seirbhís a bheidh ar fáil.

Clár um Digitíú

Digitíú pháipéir Chorcaí a bhaineann le clann Finlay agus Clann Colly ó Dhiméin Chorcaí i gCluain Dolcáin a cuireadh ar fáil do Leabharlanna Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas. Tá tionscadal i gcomhar leis an bpobal maidir le tras-scríbhinn de thaifid an tséipéil is arna sealbhú ag Leabharlann Náisiúnta na hÉireann do limistéar Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas; Tá paróistí Theach Sagard, Ráth Fearnáin, Chluain Dolcáin, Bhaile Phámar agus Leamhcháin ar fáil.

Techspace

The Techspace programme is a digital programme in Tallaght Library that concentrates on developing STEAM skills. It aims to inspire creative use of digital technology, to inspire invention and to develop thinking skills. There are currently 2 after-school clubs engaging in STEAM activities on a weekly basis. Techspace Tallaght concentrates on children of primary school age.

Fiosracht

Fiosracht (Curiosity), which has emerged from the Techspace programme is an innovative partnership between IT Tallaght, South Dublin County Library and Foróige. It aims to create a space for curious people of all ages to meet with engineers and designers to collaborate, create and share their different views and attitudes about the big issues that currently exist in the world. The programme is multi locational and managed with the intention of inspiring a conversation within the wider community on the role of engineers in society. It will have a special focus on engaging girls and their families in a discussion about what it will take to make choosing a career in engineering become commonplace for young women. Fiosracht is run during the calendar year in a series of half day, full day workshops and weeklong camps.

Techspace

Clár digiteach is ea an clár ‘Techspace’ i Leabharlann Thamhlachta a dhíríonn ar scileanna STEAM a fhorbairt. Is é is aidhm leis úsáid chruthaitheach na teicneolaíochta digití a spreagadh, fionnachtain a spreagadh agus scileanna smaointeoireachta a fhorbairt. Tá 2 chlub iarscoile páirteach i ngníomhaíochtaí STEAM faoi láthair ar bhonn seachtainiúil. Díríonn ‘Techspace’ Thamhlachta ar pháistí d’aois na bunscoile.

Fiosracht

Comhpháirtíocht nuálach is ea Fiosracht (Curiosity), a tháinig chun cinn as clár ‘Techspace’ idir Institiúid Teicneolaíochta Thamhlachta, Leabharlann Chontae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas agus Foróige. Is é is aidhm leis spás a chruthú do dhaoine fiosracha de gach aois chun buaileadh le hinnealtóirí agus dearthóirí chun comhoibriú, cruthú agus a ndeachtaí agus a dtuairimí éagsúla faoi na ceisteanna móra atá sa domhan faoi láthair a chomhroinnt. Tá an clár ar siúl ina lán suíomhanna agus déantar bainistíocht air chun comhrá a spreagadh laistigh den phobal i gcoitinne maidir le ról innealtóirí sa tsochaí. Beidh fócas speisialta ann ar pháirt a thabhairt do chailíní agus dá dteaghlaigh i bplé faoi cad le déanamh chun gairm in innealtóireacht mar rogha do chailíní óga a dhéanamh coitianta. Tá Fiosracht ar siúl i rith na bliana féilire i sraith ceardlann lae, leathlae agus campaí seachtaine.

The Culture Pod

Contact Studio will record a number of cultural events and special projects in the county to create a series of podcasts for broadcast online and for archive purposes. These will include panel discussions, headline performances, Artist profiles, Artists exchange, and documentary series.

Creative Industries Initiative

Local Enterprise Office (LEO) South Dublin will provide Creative Industries development workshops in 2017 and explore the development of a network to support the Creative Industries in the County.

In Context 4: In Our Time Public Art Programme

South Dublin County Council's Public Art Programme under Per Cent for Art Scheme aims to act as a gathering point for dialogue and a space for change. In 2017 South Dublin County Council will activate four new commissions.

- Writer Nathan O'Donnell's The Mill, will engage with a group of young people in Clondalkin to produce a magazine, derived from a history of radical publishing.
- Visual artist Fiona Dowling and composer George Higgs will collaborate with workers from a cross-section of workplaces, both industrial and rural, to create Work Songs, a musical portrait of South County Dublin's economic profile.

Soláthróidh Oifig Fiontar Áitiúil (OFÁ) Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas ceardlanna forbartha na dTionscal Cruthaitheach in 2017 agus déanfaidh siad iniúchadh ar líonra a fhorbairt chun tacú leis na Tionscail Chruthaitheacha sa Chontae.

I gComhthéacs 4 Clár Ealaíne Poiblí 'In Our Time'

Tá sé mar aidhm ag Clár Ealaíne Poiblí Chomhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas faoin Scéim an Chéatadáin le haghaidh na nEalaíon feidhmiú mar phointe bailithe do phlé agus mar spás d'athrú. In 2017 gníomhachtóidh Comhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas ceithre choimisiún úra.

- Beidh The Mill leis an scríbhneoir Nathan O'Donnell, páirteach le grúpa daoine óga i gCluain Dolcáin chun iris a chur ar fáil, a bhainfear as stair ar fhoilsiú radacach.
- Comhoibreoidh an t-amharcealaíontóir Fiona Dowling agus an cumadóir George Higgs le hoibrithe ó shampla áiteanna oibre, idir thionsclaíoch agus thuaithe, chun Work Songs, portráid cheoil de phróifíl eacnamaíoch Chontae Bhaile Átha Cliath theas a chruthú.

- Clamour & Roar – A Citizens' Chorus is a mixed discipline, multi-generational, cross-community participatory art project which will culminate in an original theatre performance devised by theatre artist Veronica Coburn.
- Inspired by Oisín i dTír na n-Óg, who carried a boulder up the mountains near Tallaght, Ciarán Taylor's Rock to the Top invites the people of South Dublin to take up the challenge of recreating this mythic feat.

NOISE Dublin

Noise Dublin creates activities and programmes for young people to take part, learn, train and work in the arts. NOISE Dublin is the Youth Arts programme offered by South Dublin County Council's Arts Office for ages 13 - 25. It is an on-line and off-line programme. It includes NOISE Flicks Film Festival; NOISE Moves Youth Dance Festival; Tallaght Young Filmmakers; and works in partnership to deliver Suburban Sounds, Creative Campus; Animakers and the Big Picture TV.

Music Generation South Dublin

Music Generation South Dublin is a music education service for children and young people that provides a range of opportunities throughout the county for children and young people to learn music. It is part of Music Generation – Ireland's National Music Education Programme, initiated by Music Network, co-funded by U2, The Ireland Funds, the Department of Education and Skills and Local Music Education Partnerships. In 2017 an early years programme will be initiated for children under 7 years and a second level schools initiative extended.

- Tionscadal ealaíne rannpháirtíoch disciplín mheasctha, ilghlúine, trasphobail is ea Clamour & Roar – A Citizens' Chorus a chríochnóidh le léiriú bunaidh téatair a chum an t-ealaíontóir téatair Veronica Coburn.

NOISE Dublin

Is é 'NOISE Dublin' clár Ealaíona na hOige atá á thairiscint ag Oifig Ealaíon Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas d'aoiseanna 13 - 25. Clár ar líne agus as líne atá ann. Áirítear air NOISE Flicks Film Festival; NOISE Moves Youth Dance Festival; Tallaght Young Filmmakers; agus oibreacha i gcomhpháirtíocht chun Suburban Sounds, Creative Campus; Animakers agus Big Picture TV a sheachadadh.

Music Generation, Baile Átha Cliath Theas

Seirbhís oideachais is ea Music Generation, Baile Átha Cliath do pháistí agus do dhaoine óga a sholáthraíonn raon deiseanna ar fud an chontae do pháistí agus do dhaoine óga chun ceol a fhoghlaim. Tá sé ina chuid de Music Generation - Clár Náisiúnta Oideachais Ceoil na hÉireann, arna thionscain ag Music Network, agus cómhaoinithe ag U2, Cistí na hÉireann agus an Roinn Oideachais agus Scileanna agus Comhpháirtíochtaí Áitiúla um Oideachas Ceoil. In 2017 cuirfear tús le clár luathbhlianta do pháistí faoi bhun 7 mbliana d'aois agus sínfear tionscnamh scoileanna dara leibhéal.

Ruaille Buaille Lucan Childrens Music Festival

Ruaille Buaille is a children's music festival 7-10 June, 2017 featuring a programme of music workshops, performances and outdoor events. 2017 will see the launch an Early Years Festival Tent @ Griffeen Park to compliment the main tent. As well as performances in the tent, there will be plenty happening in the park including face-painting, circus performers and pop-up shows in a great family day out.

Red Line Book Festival

The Red Line Book Festival, 11-15 October 2017, is the main cultural festival of South Dublin County Council and its development is part of the action plan of the Council Tourism Strategy. In 2017 the festival will feature some 40 events. Highlights will include live broadcast of RTE's Sunday Miscellany at the Civic Theatre, Tallaght, events for a newly established literary strand - aimed at providing a platform for emerging writers and poets - and an exciting primary schools programme which will expose children to literature, drama, art and music.

Ruaille Buaille, Féile Cheoil Leamhcáin do Pháistí

Féile cheoil do pháistí is ea Ruaille Buaille, 7-10 Meitheamh, 2017 ina mbeidh clár ceardlann ceoil, léiriúcháin agus imeachtaí faoin aer. Lainseálfar Puball Féile na Luathbhlianta @ Páirc na Grífiní chun an príomhphuball a chomhlánú in 2017. Chomh maith le léiriúcháin sa phuball, beidh go leor ag tarlú sa pháirc lena n-áirítear péinteáil aghaidheanna, léiritheoirí sorcais agus seónna mír aníos i lá iontach don teaghlach ar fad.

Féile Leabhar na Líne Deirge.

Is í Féile Leabhar na Líne Deirge, 11-15 Deireadh Fómhair 2017, an phríomhfhéile chultúrtha de chuid Chomhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas agus tá a forbairt mar chuid de phlean gníomhaíochta Straitéis Turasóireachta na Comhairle. Beidh thart ar 40 imeacht ar siúl i bhféile 2017. Áireofar ar na buaicphointí craoladh beo de Sunday Miscellany RTÉ ag an Amharclann Phobail, Tamhlacht, imeachtaí do shraith litríochta nuabhunaithe - a dhíríonn ar ardán a chur ar fáil do scríbhneoirí agus d'fhilí atá ag teacht chun cinn – agus clár iontach do bhunscoileanna ina gcuirfear litríocht, drámaíocht, ealaín agus ceol i láthair páistí.

Unwrapped Winter Festival

This annual programme is developed by a creative partnership of South Dublin County Council Arts Office and Corporate Services Department; South Dublin County Libraries; Tallaght Community Arts; Alternative Entertainments; CONTACT Studio; Civic Theatre, Tallaght; RUA RED, South Dublin Arts Centre. This inclusive event will feature 300 children, young people and adults from South Dublin County's youth, schools and community arts groups. It is an outdoor spectacle with original music, choreography and costume and lantern designs.

The Tenderfoot Programme

The Civic Theatre will continue to develop its unique and highly regarded Tenderfoot Programme which enables a range of secondary schools to engage directly with the performing arts over a four month period through a mentor led programme of skills development that enables an ensemble of up to 50 transition year students to spend a month in the building writing, producing, designing and acting in a series of self-penned plays that are presented to a peer-to-peer audience in January. Going forward the programme will be branching out to include direct mentor led facilitation of visits to arts and theatre projects, with pre-visit and post-visit analysis to encourage a culture of arts appreciation beyond the demands of the curriculum. This programme will be further supported by the theatre's new 'Inspire' programme whereby adult theatre attendees are encouraged to donate towards the purchase of heavily subsidised or free tickets so as to encourage young people to attend theatre and arts events in the region.

An Fhéile Gheimhridh 'Unwrapped'

Tá an clár bliantúil seo forbartha ag comhpháirtíocht chruthaitheach Oifig Ealaíon Chomhairle Contae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas agus an Rannóg Seirbhísí Corparáideacha; Leabharlann Chontae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas; Ealaíona Pobail Thamhlachta; Alternative Entertainments, Stiúideo CONTACT, RED RUA, Ionad Ealaíon Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas. Beidh 300 páiste, duine óg agus aosach ó ghrúpaí óige, scoileanna agus ealaíon pobail ó Chontae Bhaile Átha Cliath Theas páirteach san imeacht cuimsitheach seo. Seó faoin aer atá ann ina mbeidh ceol bunaidh, cóiragrafaíocht agus dearáí éidí agus laindéir.

Clár 'Tenderfoot'

Leanfaidh an Amharclann Phobail lena Clár 'Tenderfoot' atá uathúil agus a bhfuil an-mheas air ina gcuirtear ar chumas raon meánscoileanna páirt dhíreach a ghlacadh sna healaíon taibhithe thar thréimhse ceithre mhí trí chlár faoi stiúir meantóra d'fhorbairt scileanna faoinar féidir le ensemble suas le 50 dalta ón idirbhliain mí a chaitheamh san fhoirgneamh ag scríobh, ag léiriú, ag dearadh agus ag aisteoireacht i sraith drámaí féinscríofa a chuirfear i láthair lucht féachana/éisteachta piara le piara i mí Eanáir. Ag dul chun tosaigh síneofar an clár chun éascaíocht cuairteanna faoi stiúir dhíreach meantóra ar thionscadail ealaíon agus amharclannaíochta a chur san áireamh, agus déanfar anailís réamhchualaithe agus iarchualaithe chun tuiscint ar chultúr na n-ealaíon thar éilimh an churaclaim a spreagadh.
