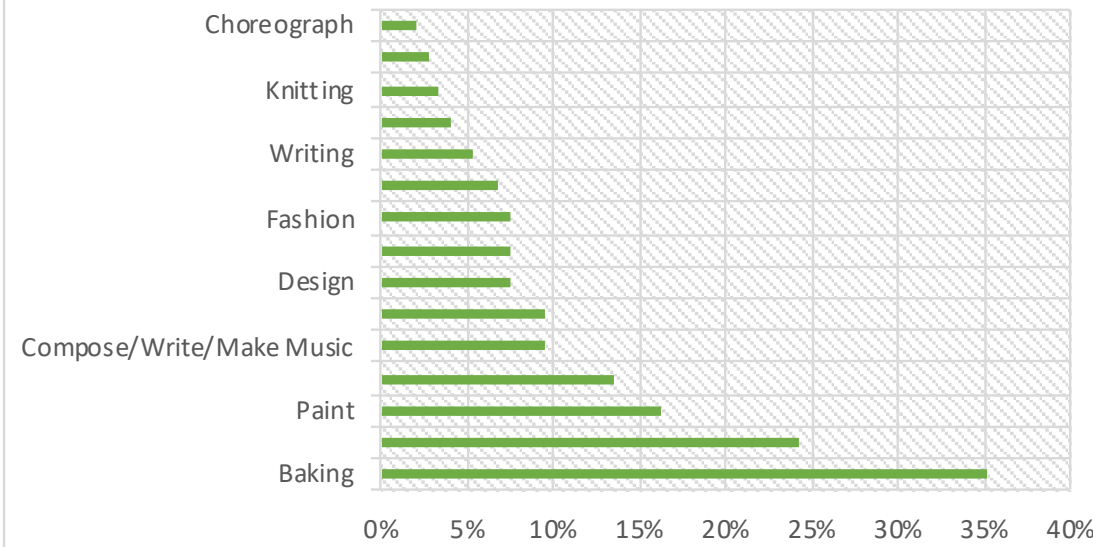
The survey was carried out between November and December 2020. 148 participants completed online surveys. A summary of the results are as follows:



Where did you hear about this survey?

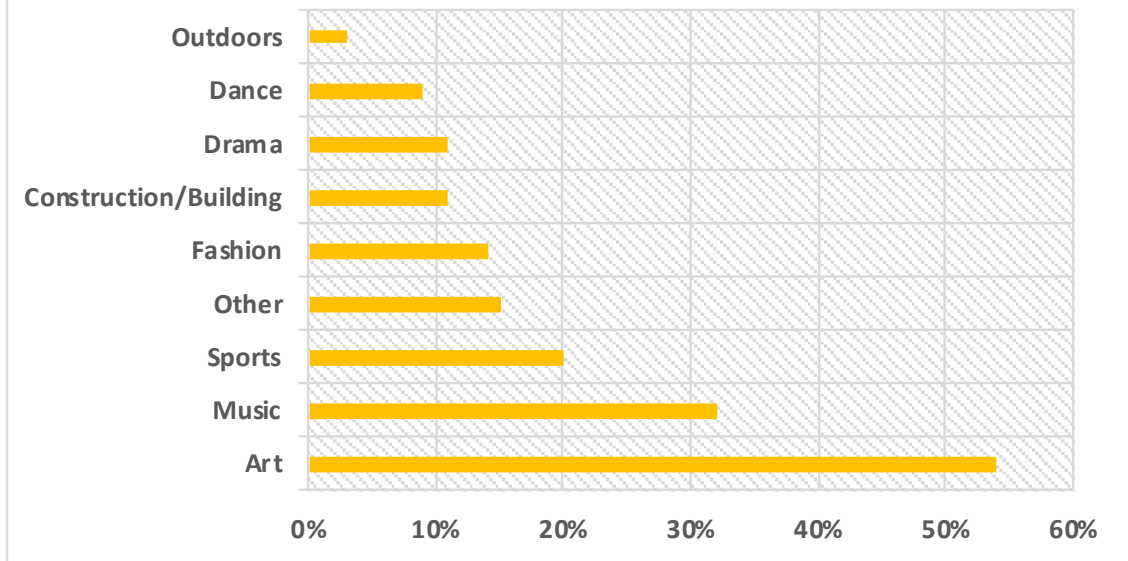


What creative things do you like making?

Fashion - *Hair, Makeup, Sewing, Knitting*

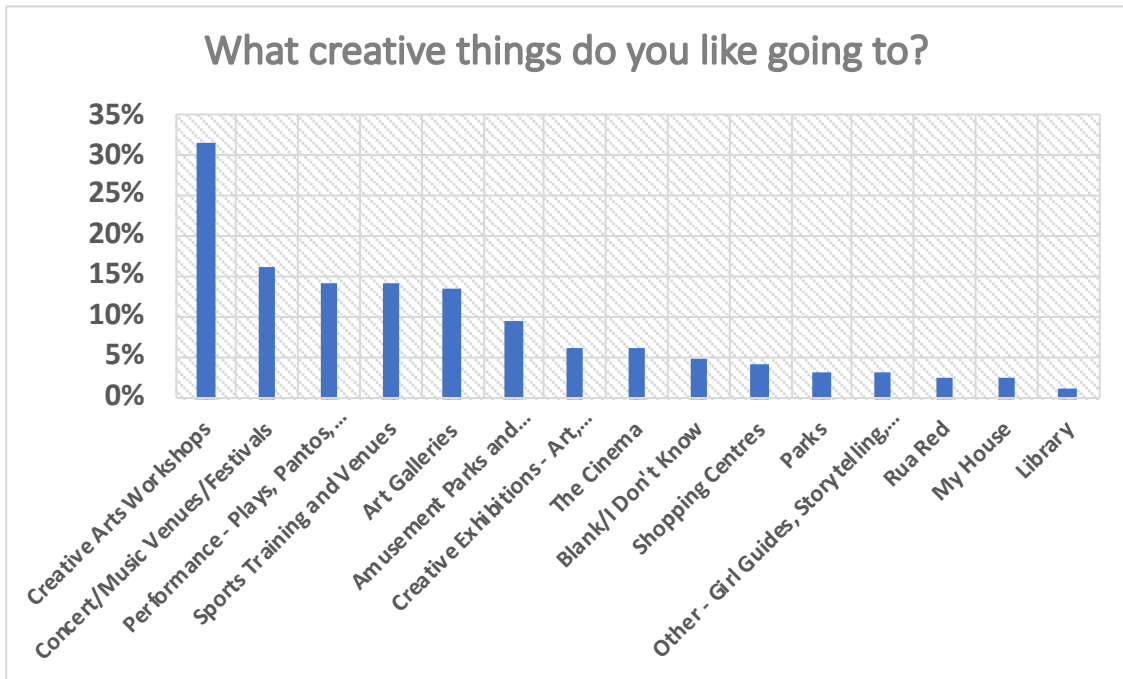
Sports - *Horse Riding, Gymnastics, Games*

Construction/Building - *Interior Design, Design, Pottery, Origami, Making Gadgets, Lego, Sculpture*

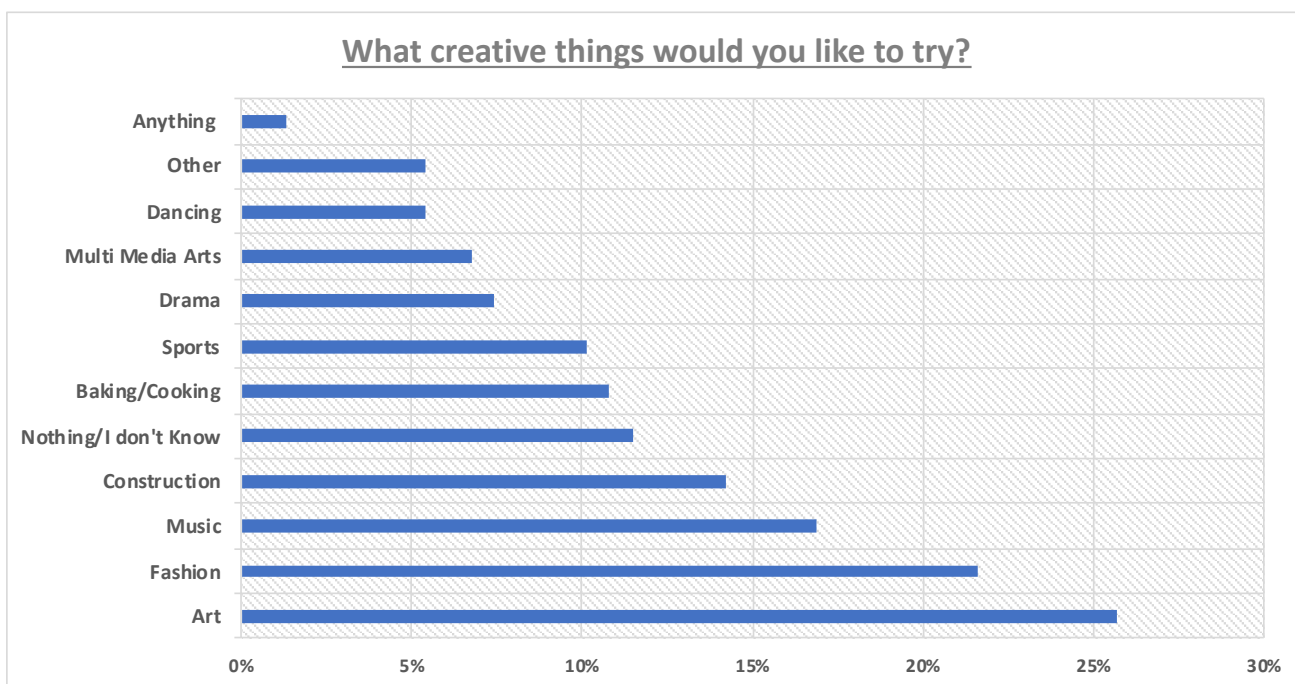
Drama - *Performing, Acting*

Fashion - *Knitting, Crochet, Tie Dye, Sewing, Hair, Makeup*

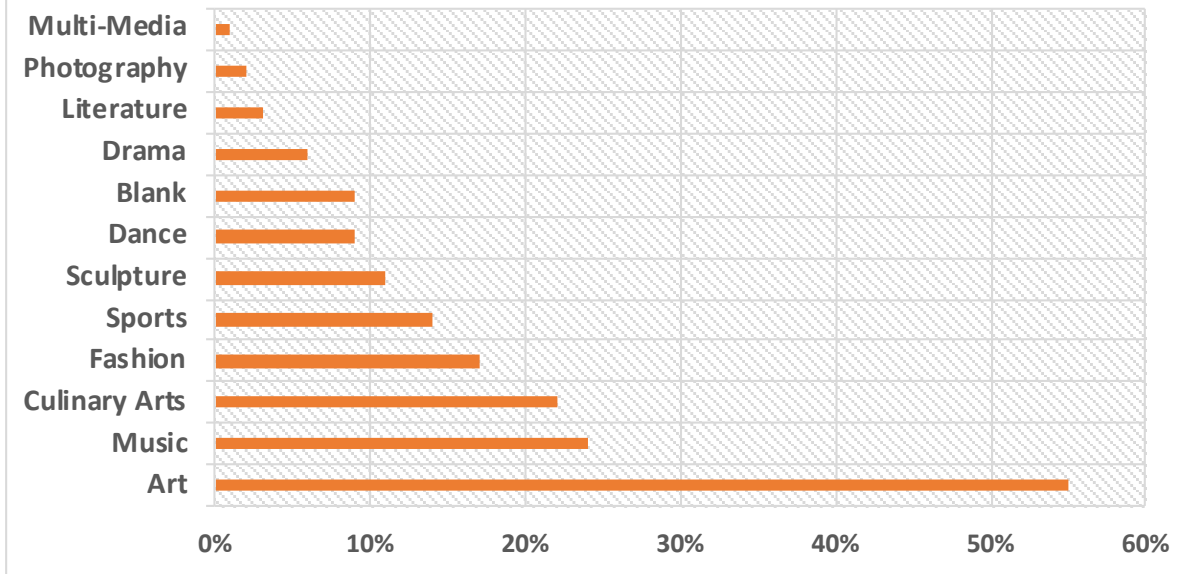
Multi Media Arts - *Photography, Videography, Animation, Lego Movie*
