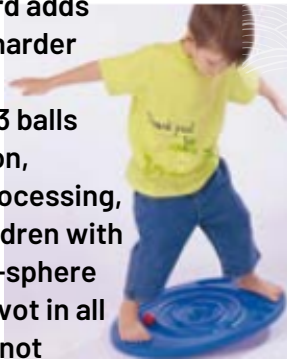


TTT - SENSORY TOYS

The maze on this balance board adds an extra challenge, making it harder than a standard balance board. The board comes with 3 balls and helps improve coordination, rhythm, auditory and visual processing, and motor coordination in children with sensory challenges. The semi-sphere fulcrum allows the board to pivot in all directions, engaging muscles not exercised by rocker boards.

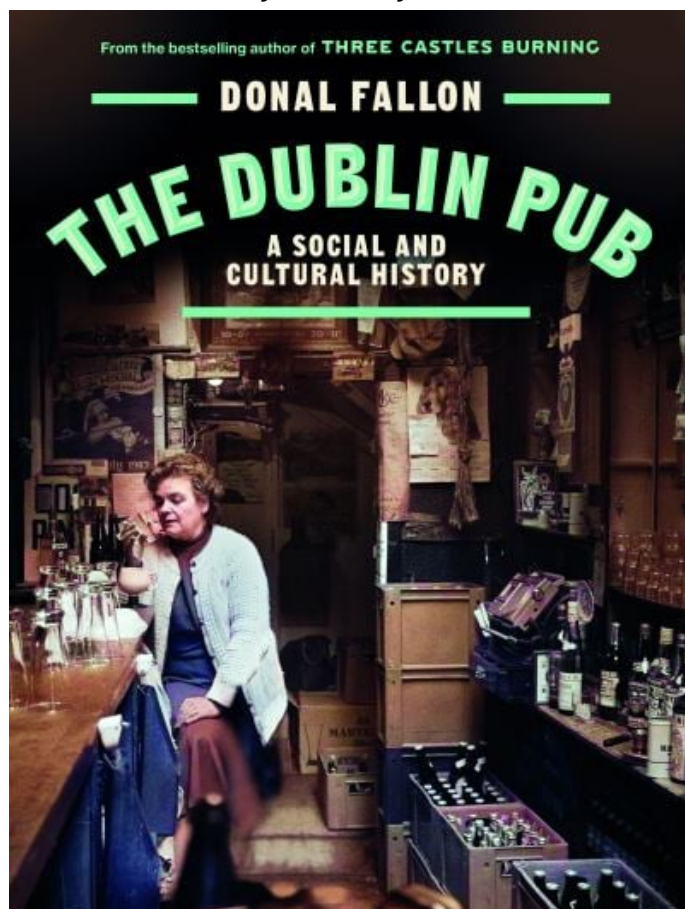


THE DUBLIN PUB: A SOCIAL AND CULTURAL HISTORY WITH AUTHOR DONAL FALLON

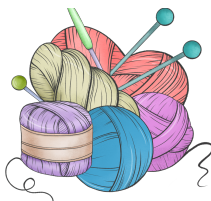
Creating a garden that can become your own sanctuary is a great way to improve your wellbeing and have a wonderful space to enjoy year round.
