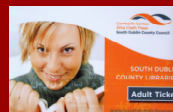
Clondalkin Library will close on Monday 23rd December at 8.00 pm and re-open on Thursday 2nd January at 9.45am

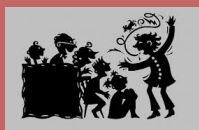


Winter Wonder Stories
