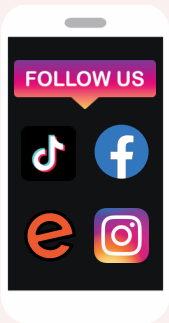

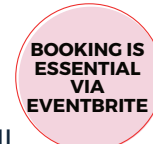
MAKER SPACE TEEN TOTE BAGS
