The workshop integrates techniques to help access and express emotions, relaxing children into art practice, both outdoors and indoors using textile, printmaking and photography techniques.


Working with vegetation collected in the outdoors, the children will explore ideas of care in the natural environment, discover local biodiversity, connect and draw from nature.
