

My Open Library

My Open Library is a unique service that offers **extended library opening hours** by allowing access to registered My Open Library members **outside of staffed hours**.



How does it work?

- You must go through an **induction** with staff before you can register for MOL.
- Once registered, you can **scan your library card** at the door to enter the library during My Open Library Hours.
- My Open Library will let you enter the library between **8am and 10pm** every day - even bank holidays!

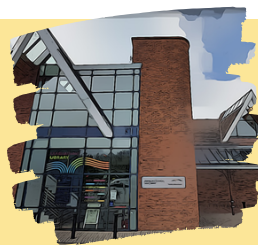
