

A Little Birdie Told Me workshop with Tarsila Kruse





Thursday July 31st, 2pm & 3pm




Join the Glow Group and solve some engineering challenges using Lego. There will be two sessions available on the day. The 2pm session is suitable for children with additional needs.




Creative writing workshop suitable for children ages 8+. Children will learn about the classic poem and learn how to write their own poem.




