Baby Tummy Time

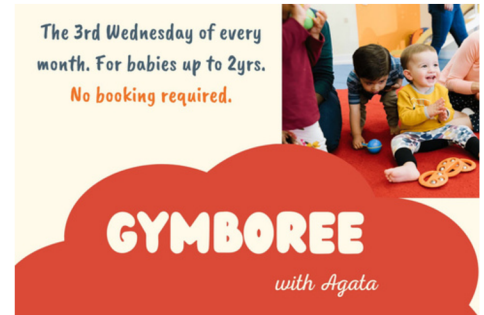
