



The Story of the Female Pilots – a talk by Michael Traynor

Tuesday 14th 7pm

Tallaght Historical Society presents a talk by Limerick author, historian and pilot, Michael Traynor.

Titled "The Story of the Female Pilots", the talk explores the lives and stories of Ireland's pioneer female pilots of the early 20th Century. Drawn from every social class, these

women made headlines and were celebrated in the 1920s and '30s. Since then their names have largely disappeared from the historical record.

Michael is the author of "Petticoat Pilots" which was published in two volumes. In the books he recalls the lives and achievements of these pioneering aviatrices, many of whom will be recalled in our talk.
